Wind Turbine Project

Paul Cowley and Tom Latter gave an overview of what the project would entail and how the existing turbine has given back to the community. The group were looking to purchase a larger turbine that would be 50% bigger in dimension. It would produce 4 times the output and twice the power. It was noted that an application would be submitted in July and a verdict was likely to be received 3 to 6 months later.

Minutes of last meeting

Minute of the last meeting were agreed as a true record. D Williams proposed and A Phillips seconded. All were in favour.

1. Matters Arising

- 1.1 Asset transfer – Cllr Harries and Cllr Raymond met with Becky Scott from the Local Authority to discuss agreed areas. 12.5 metres had been measured from the fence. All were in favour of this proposal.
- 1.2 Bus stop – it was noted that the bus stop had been repaired. However, it had not been carried out by Kevin Claypole. Kevin had purchased all materials etc and was unable to get a full refund on this. It was agreed that Scleddau Community Council would pay for the bill. A Anderson proposed, all were in favour.
- 1.3 Doing the small things grant – Further information was required for the application to be successful. This was discussed and the Clerk would respond on behalf of the Community Council.

2. Agenda Items

- 2.1 Community Grant Funding – It was felt that the Community Council would concentrate on the existing application of the 'Doing the Small Things grant' before any further applications would be made.

- 2.2 Ysgol Casmael 70th Anniversary – It was noted that a lot of children within the Community Council area attended Ysgol Casmael. It was agreed to donate £250 towards the event. M Scrimshaw proposed and D Hadan seconded. All were in favour.
- 2.3 Notice of Election – Forms were printed to be displayed in the notice boards to inform residents of the forthcoming election.
- 2.4 2023/24 Audit- The audit had been completed for the financial year 2023-24. The Clerk asked for the Chair to have a look prior to submitting it to the auditor to finalise.

3. Planning applications

Mill Farm, Manorowen – Replace existing pole from 9.5m to 11m. All were in favour of the proposal.

The Roft, 15 Chapel Road, Dwrbach – use of existing residential annex into holiday let. The councillors were happy to agree, on condition that parking was not to be allowed on the road.

Meadow Lake, Dwrbach – 100kw solar array comprising of 5 29x4m ground units. The Councillors objected to the proposal.

Llwynon, Dwrbach – Double garage extension to side of dwelling. All were in favour.
