1. Matters Arising

- 1.1 Asset Transfer – It was agreed to continue with the Asset Transfer work with Helen Hodges. The agreed quote was £1500 for both transfers.
- 1.2 Fishguard AFC – Following the submission of further information, it was agreed to donate £200 towards the materials of the recent works that has been carried out at Tregroes. M Scrimshaw proposed the amount and A Phelps seconded. All were in favour.
- 1.3 Salt bins – All salt bins in parish were to be replenished in the coming weeks.
