Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were signed as a true record proposed by M Scrimshaw and seconded by J Miles. All were in favour.

1. Matters Arising

- 1.1 Asset Transfer and Property – It was noted following an email from the solicitor outlining that the land registry for both sites could take several months to conclude. It was agreed to email Becky Scott from Property to ask if work could be carried out on the land whilst awaiting the land registry. It was also agreed to email Jane Bent to ask a breakdown of the grant that was agreed for the play equipment. The clerk would also request catalogues from companies to determine equipment that would be purchased. The clerk would also email Abergrass, where a previous quote was received, to find out the costs for upkeeping both sites.
- 1.2 Hall Charges – It was noted that the Community Council were awaiting an invoice from the YFC regarding charges for the Hall.

6. PCC report

- Speed limit was going to be taken to consultation

- The Local Authority were looking at Venues locally to build Social Care Centres.

- Cllr Harries was looking had questioned the local authority what investment will be made in the North end of the County. For instance the astro turf in Fishguard had been in situ for 12 years. So he queried what investment will be made in Fishguard.
