Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were signed as a true record proposed by W Miles and seconded by M Scrimshaw. All were in favour.

1. Matters Arising

Had been received

- 1.1 Asset Transfer and Property – It was noted that following correspondence from the local authority, there was no requirement to wait for the land registry to be completed prior to undertaking the work on both of the fields in Scleddau and Trecwn.
- 1.2 The Clerk had been in touch with Abergrass, who confirmed that the quote for cutting each field would be £65 each. It was felt that upkeep of the grass would be every three weeks to begin with and then review.
- 1.3 Cllrs were provided with a list of play equipment providers to see what equipment would be suitable for the community. It was decided that the Clerk would contact all providers to get quotes. The main requirements were a double swing with flat seats and a toddler swing and a rocker. Mats would also be required.
- 1.4 Hall Charges – Julia would get in touch with Ffion to ask for an invoice.

2. Agenda Items

- 2.1 Wales Audit Office – Invoices had been received relating to financial years 21/22 and 22/23 totalling £973. The Clerk would contact Wales Audit to find out further information.
